To protect consumers and safeguard public health and safety, the **Standards Organisation of Nigeria (SON)** introduced the **SONCAP** programme.

Established in 2005, **SONCAP** helps prevent substandard, unsafe, and counterfeit products from entering the Nigerian market by ensuring regulated products comply with applicable standards before shipment.

As an approved Conformity Assessment Body, Intertek supports exporters and importers throughout the **SONCAP** compliance process, enabling smooth customs clearance, seamless market access to Nigeria, and helping businesses Trade with Assurance.

What is Intertek's role?

Certification Requirements

Under SONCAP, regulated products must comply with applicable Nigerian Industrial Standards (NIS) or approved equivalent standards before importation into Nigeria.

Two mandatory certificates are required:



Product Certificate (PC): Issued for compliant products under all certification routes and required for E-Form M processing.



SONCAP Certificate (SC): Issued for each compliant shipment and required for customs clearance.

Both certificates are issued in the exporting country following conformity assessment activities, including documentation review, product testing, and inspection. Failure to comply may result in customs delays, penalties, or rejected shipments.

Required Documentation

Every consignment containing regulated products must:



Have a valid Product Certificate (PC) issued by an approved Inspection and Accreditation Firm (IAF), such as Intertek.



Be accompanied by a SONCAP Certificate (SC) issued by your local Intertek office prior to shipment for customs clearance in Nigeria.



Comply with applicable Nigerian Industrial Standards (NIS) or approved equivalent standards, as confirmed by the SONCAP Certificate (SC).



Be aware that Nigerian authorities may conduct random compliance checks. Most products are covered under SONCAP unless specifically exempted or prohibited by SON or other Nigerian authorities.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION?

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CERTIFICATION PROCESS AND ROUTES



Three streamlined certification routes are available to support exporters, applicants, and manufacturers. Each route provides a clear pathway to compliance, ensuring products reach their destination efficiently and with assurance.

Under the SONCAP Programme, a mandatory Product Certificate (PC) is issued with a validity period of six months to one year, subject to the applicable certification rules, while a SONCAP Certificate (SC) is required and issued for every shipment.

For Occasional Exporters

Route A

Unregistered or Unlicensed Status

PC 1 is issued to all type of Applicants with occasional exports to Nigeria and may be used for single shipment within 6 months from the date of issue.

PC 2 is issued to applicants and may be used for multiple shipments for a period of one year from the date of issue.

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REGULATED PRODUCTS

The SONCAP conformity assessment programme applies to a wide range of imported products, while certain product categories are exempt from its requirements. The regulated and exempted products are outlined below.



Regulated Products

The Nigeria SONCAP Regulated products include the following but are not limited to:

Electrical and Electronics



Automotive



Chemical Products



Building & Construction Materials



Mechanical Materials & Gas Appliances



Paper and Stationery



Protective Safety Equipment



Textile and Textile Products

Leather, Plastic and Rubber Products

Life-Endangering Products

The following life-endangering products require mandatory inspection and testing. These products are not limited to the categories listed:



Electrical and Electronic products such as Electrical cables, fuses, Switches, Solar Panels etc.



Building products such as Cements, Iron and Steel products, Gypsum, Gas Heater etc.



Automotive Products such as Automobile Glass, Safety Belts, Brake pads, Tyres etc.



Chemical Products such as Fertilizers, Paints, Brake Fluid, Stabilizers etc.

Exempted Products

SONCAP programme exempted products include the following:



Food products



Medicines and Pharmaceuticals



Medicals other than equipment and machines.



Chemicals used as raw materials by bonafide manufacturers



Military wares and equipment



Imports classified as contraband by the Federal Government of Nigeria



Used products other than automobiles



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FEE STRUCTURE

Fees for conformity assessment under Nigeria SONCAP are outlined below:

Notes

1. The above-mentioned SONCAP certificate fees cover the documentary verification, inspection of goods and container sealing (where applicable)
2. The above-mentioned fees exclude laboratory testing, re-inspection fees, applicable taxes and any other applicable charges.

Compliance Reminder

1. Selecting the appropriate certification route and completing conformity assessment prior to shipment helps avoid:
2. Clearance delays
3. Additional costs
4. Penalties or surcharges
5. Destination inspection or rejection of goods
6. Early engagement with an authorised SONCAP International Accredited Firm (IAF) is strongly recommended.
